SleepSafe is providing meals to homeless charities

SleepSafe is expanding its support for homeless charities by providing meals during the COVID-19 crisis to help solve the increasing food security issue.

Sheridan has worked closely with charity partner StreetSmart Australia to help direct SleepSafe donations where they're most needed during these uncertain times.

"Right now charity meals programs are shut across the country. With gatherings restricted and older volunteers protecting their health, food security for vulnerable Australians is an emerging challenge.

Our *SmartMeals* program is employing hospitality venues to provide meals for their local homeless charities. This means donations have double the impact by keeping hospitality workers in jobs and feeding the homeless and vulnerable," said Geoff Hills, Chief Operations and Fundraising, StreetSmart Australia.

To date, SleepSafe has provided over 6,000 Sleep Kits (a sheet set and towel) to people in need and will continue to distribute the rest of the available kits while also raising funds for meals. For every \$10 raised, a meal will be provided to someone in need.

Paul Gould, Group General Manager, Sheridan, said, "During these challenging times, it's important for us to support our charity partner in every way we can. Vulnerable communities are being hit the hardest during COVID-19 and this complex situation is putting an additional strain on already stretched homeless services. The strength and success of the SleepSafe initiative has allowed us to rework our approach to suit the current landscape and provide food and meal support to those who need it most."
